

SUBJECT : ASSESSMENT CRITERIA FOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES

ASSESSMENT

The assessment of students in course consists of continuous assessment and the final examination. The continuous assessment and the final examination are respectively weighted as 50-50% for degree programmes.

The continuous assessment consists of tests, assignments, projects and any other work that may be assigned by a lecturer.

The continuous assessment consists of a least two assessments in each term.

GRADING

The following grading scheme shall be used to grade all work.

86 – 100%	A+	Distinction
76 – 85%	A	Distinction
68 – 75%	B+	Meritorious
62 – 67%	B	Very Satisfactory
56 – 61%	C+	Definite Pass
50 – 55%	C	Bare Pass
40 – 49%	D+	Bare Fail
0 – 39%	D	Definite Fail

GRADUATION

A student must fulfill the following *requirements* to qualify for graduation;

- i. Must have passed **all courses** of the programme undertaken
- ii. Must have passed **practical training** during industrial attachment

CLASSIFICATION OF DEGREES

- i. To pass a course a student must score at least a **C** or **50%**
- ii. Bachelor's degrees classified as **Distinction, Merit, Credit** or **Pass**

To calculate the grade of the degree, the following is applied using grades obtained in **third** to **fourth/fifth** year.
